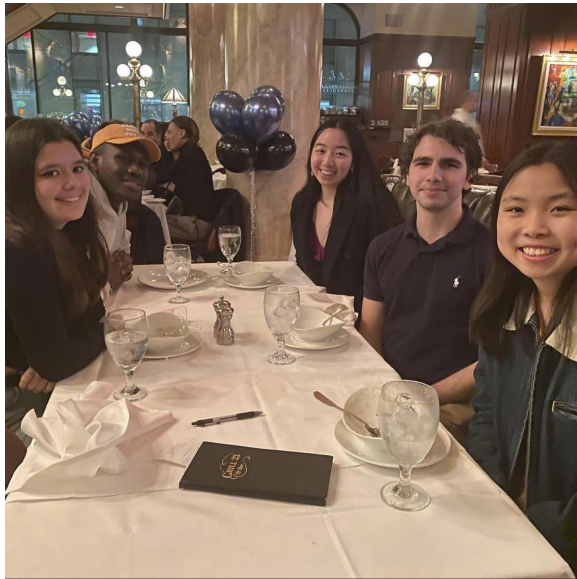
There's much in store for this class, and we're excited that they're all ready to see the group flourish in the coming years.
